What? Hampshire Dance is in the process of updating our Dance in Schools Directory, and we are looking for dance practitioners to be listed within it. *Dance in Schools: a directory of dance practitioners for the south east*, is a resource for potential employers in the south east who are seeking to recruit artists to lead dance activity in schools. The directory is available to Partnership Development Managers, School Sports Co-ordinators and teachers across the region. It is free for artists to be listed in the Directory, and if you want to work in schools it is a fantastic opportunity to reach potential employers and generate work. DTAP and Trinity College London launch a new Diploma in Dance Teaching & Learning (Children & Young People)

A new national qualification – The Diploma in Dance Teaching and Learning focussing on working with children and young people – has successfully gained accreditation from the Qualifications and Curriculum Authority and is now available to the dance sector through the international examinations board Trinity College London. The diploma is the first of its kind, designed for practitioners working outside of formal education with children and young people, and has been developed at the request of the major national dance organisations and led by Youth Dance England on behalf of DTAP.
